On October 11, the Lafarge Eastern Canada land management team joined the Conservation Halton group at the inaugural Halton Forest Festival to teach students and their families about the local ecosystems in their community. As a Tree Level sponsor, Lafarge donated three loads of stone to help spruce up the trails between the various activity tents, which was in desperate need of repair and had lots of tripping hazards and potholes.



The Halton Forest Festival took place from October 10 - 13, 2012. The four day outdoor event was hosted at Rattlesnake Point Conservation Area. The first three days saw a thousand grade 6 and 7 students learning through outdoor activities that allowed them to immerse themselves in their local environment. The last day was open to the community during Conservation Halton's Fall into Nature. The Public Day provided the Halton community with a chance to partake in forest related activities and presentations giving landowners new knowledge and resources.
